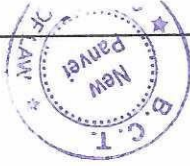

Bhagubai Changu Thakur College of Law, New Panvel has arranged 5th Janardan Bhagat Memorial lecture series, on 24th and 25th march 2023. Today on 24th, Lectures on theme of Law of Evidence were arranged.

Advocate Mr. Anil Arjun Jadhav sir addressed the students with his immense knowledge. Sir is practising in Civil and Criminal matters since last 20 years. He has completed his law education from New Law College, Mahim and currently practising in Panvel Court. Jadhav Sir, focused on certain sections from The Indian Evidence Act having crucial importance like sec. 25, sec. 26, and sec 27. He explained how Sec.25 and Sec.26 provides admissibility of confession by accused to police officer and while under police custody. Further he explained importance of sec.27, i.e How much of information received from accused may be proved. Sir explained the relation of Art.20 (3) under Constitution of India, which provides for right of the accused to remain silence and no person can be compelled to witness against himself. And on the other hand under evidence act, confessions and statements given by accused be used against him.

In the second half, Adv Monali Subhash Patil madam delivered a lecture on the topic "Electronic Evidence". Adv. Patil madam had done LLM from Mumbai University and having experience of 9 years in civil and criminal practice at Hon'ble High Court Mumbai. Madam has been appointed as Amicus curie in various matters and also on Legal Council on Legal Aid panel High Court Mumbai.

In accordance to the topic, focus of her lecture was on Sec. 65A and 65B of Indian Evidence Act. Madam very nicely explained how various electronic evidences are collected, admissibility of electronic evidence prior and after amendment. Changes after amendment, particularly with respect to importance of Digital certificate under sec.65B. How there are various authorities or stages while establishing electronic evidence. First authority is the owner of the electronic device in which the electronic record or evidence is generated. This further travels through electronic evidence analysing authority then the public prosecutor produces it to the Court. Thus, as against



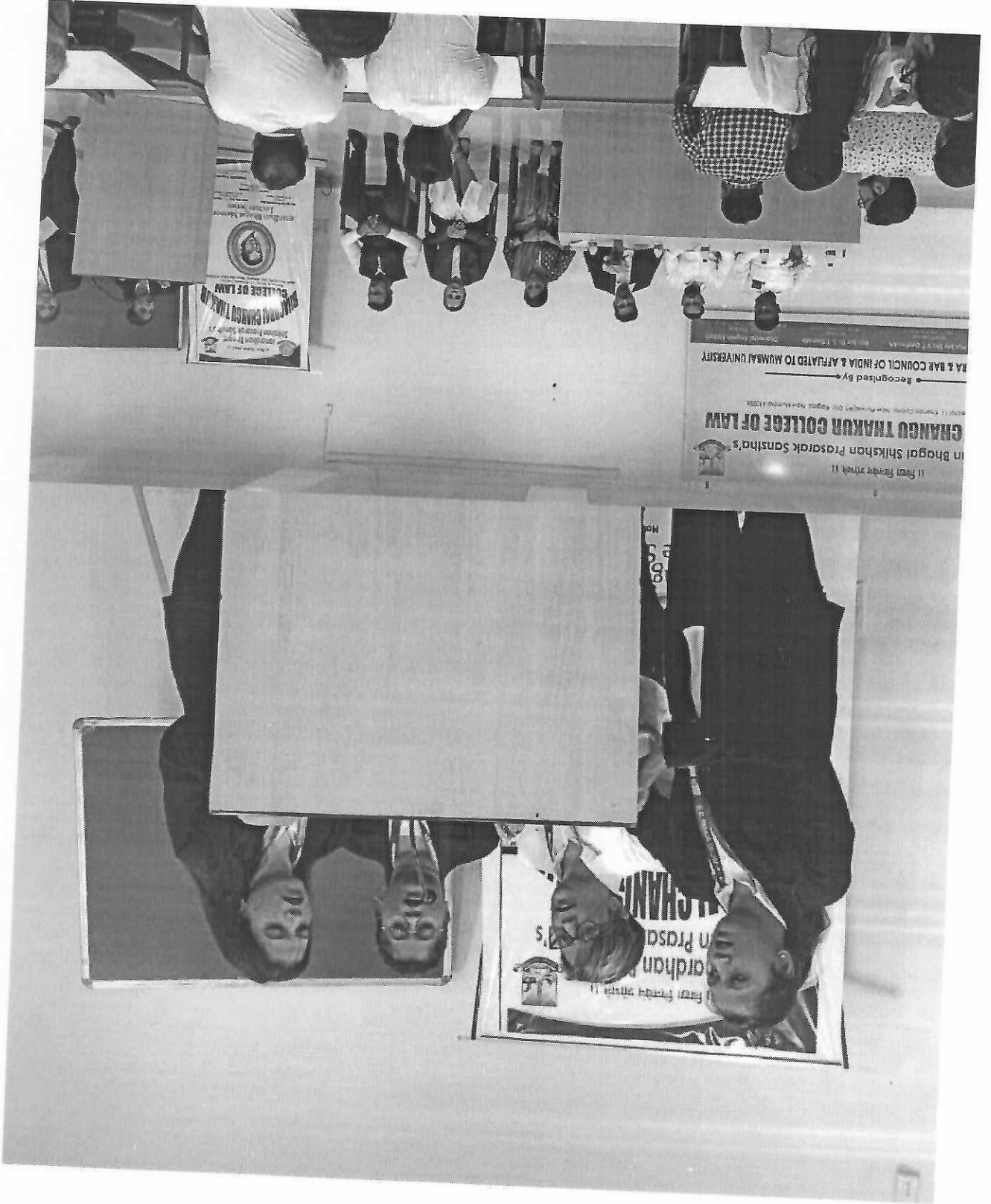
any general documentary evidence, establishing electronic evidence is altogether a different process wherein digital certificate is of crucial importance.

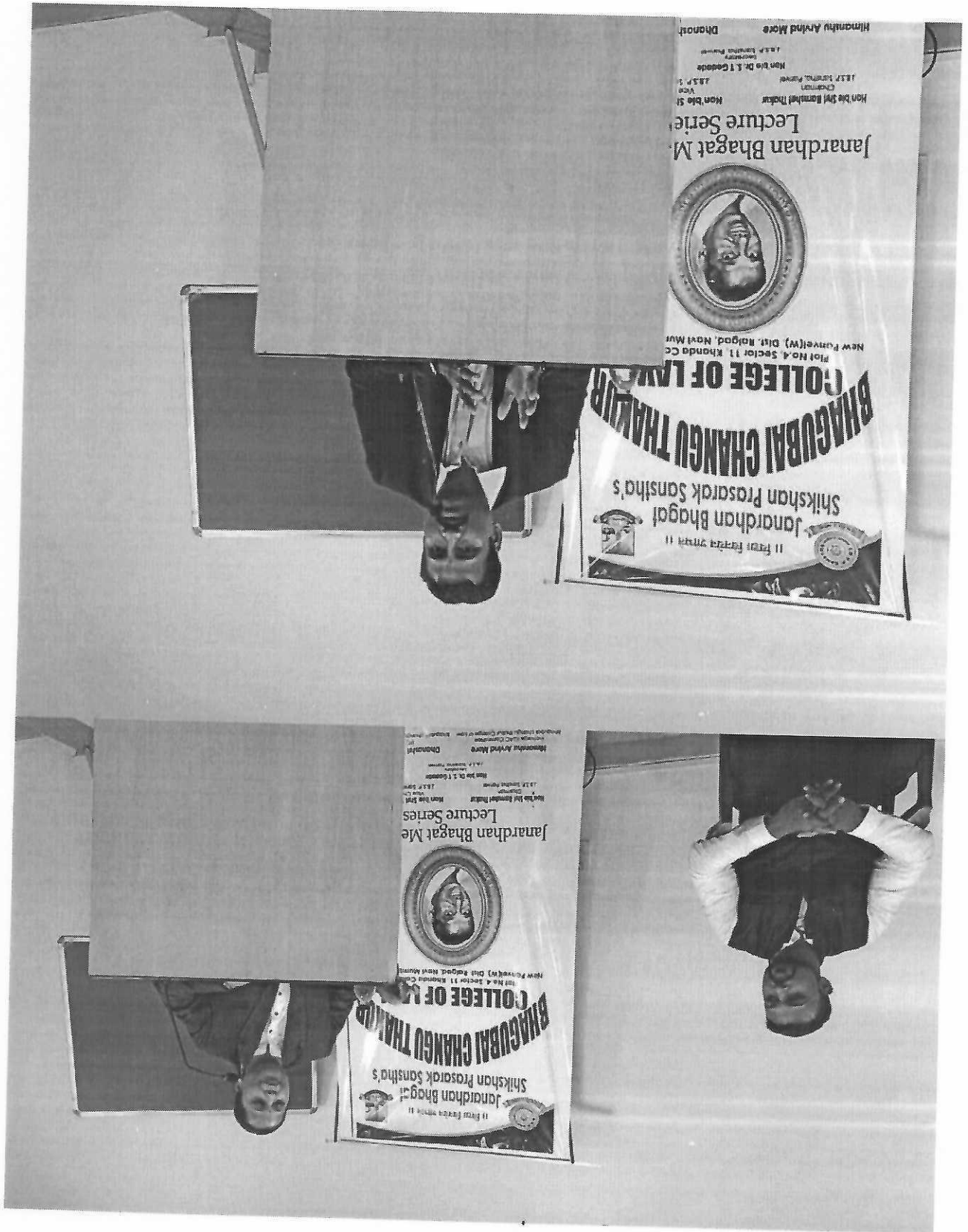
